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Bridging the Gap with Prescription Assistance

Mission

MedBank is a volunteer organization that makes certain prescription medications available to needy residents of Chatham, Effingham, and Bryan Counties with chronic health conditions

How MedBank Works

- Helps patients access drug manufacturer's Patient Assistance Programs to obtain prescription medications free-of-charge
 - Referrals are accepted by fax or mail at any time
 - We fill out the applications for each medication a patient needs
 - Signed and processed applications are mailed to the pharmaceutical companies
- The physicians receives 90 day supply of medications from the pharmaceutical companies and provides it to their patients
- New/Current patients may receive an initial 30 day supply of medications if funding is available

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What you need to bring:

- Copies of all insurance cards
 - Medicaid Denial letter
- Income proof for everyone in the household (within the last 30 days)
 - Most recent income tax return
- Social Security, Supplemental SS, and Social Security Disability benefit letter
 - Copy of Pension benefit statement
 - Last 3 paystubs
 - Alimony, Child Support, TANF and Food Stamps
- Support from family or friends (food, bills, shelter, etc.)
 - Worker's Comp.
 - Unemployment benefit letter
- Most recent Checking/Saving account bank statements
