Please call and schedule an appointment to be seen. For new patients, the wait time for an initial evaluation is approximately 6 to 8 weeks. Walk-Ins are accepted. However, patients with appointments are seen first.

REQUIRED FOR PATIENT REGISTRATION:

- Verification of current address such as: Driver's License, Utility Bill or Telephone Bill
- Verification of Insurance such as: Medicaid, Medicare, or Private Insurance
- Proof of household income such as: Earnings, Social Security, Child Support, Unemployment and/or Worker's Compensation

Discounts on services are available to qualifying patients. Eligibility is based on family income and family size.
