The Georgia Crisis and Access Line is available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week and 365 days a year to help you or someone you care for in a crisis. GCAL professionals will:

- Provide telephonic crisis intervention services
- Dispatch mobile crisis teams
- Assist individuals in finding an open crisis or detox bed across the State
- Link individuals with urgent appointment services
- Help you to access a State Funded provider in your area in a non-emergency.



The National Suicide Prevention Lifeline provides 24/7, free and confidential emotional support and resources to people in suicidal crisis or emotional distress, prevention and crisis resources for you or your loved ones, and best practices for professionals. They also have a 24/7 online chat service available on their website.



The Veterans Crisis Line connects veterans in crisis and their families and friends with qualified, caring Department of Veterans Affairs responders through a confidential toll-free hotline, online chat, or text. Confidential support is available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, 365 days a year. Support for deaf and hard of hearing individuals is available.
