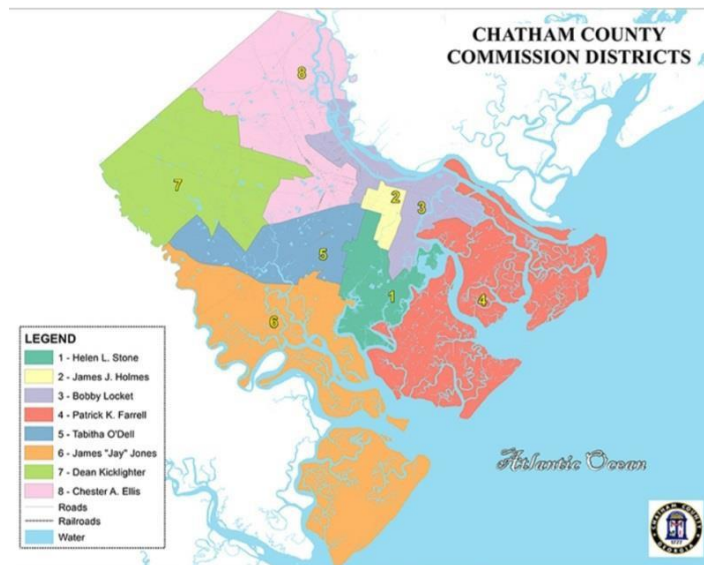


# Homeless Resource Guide

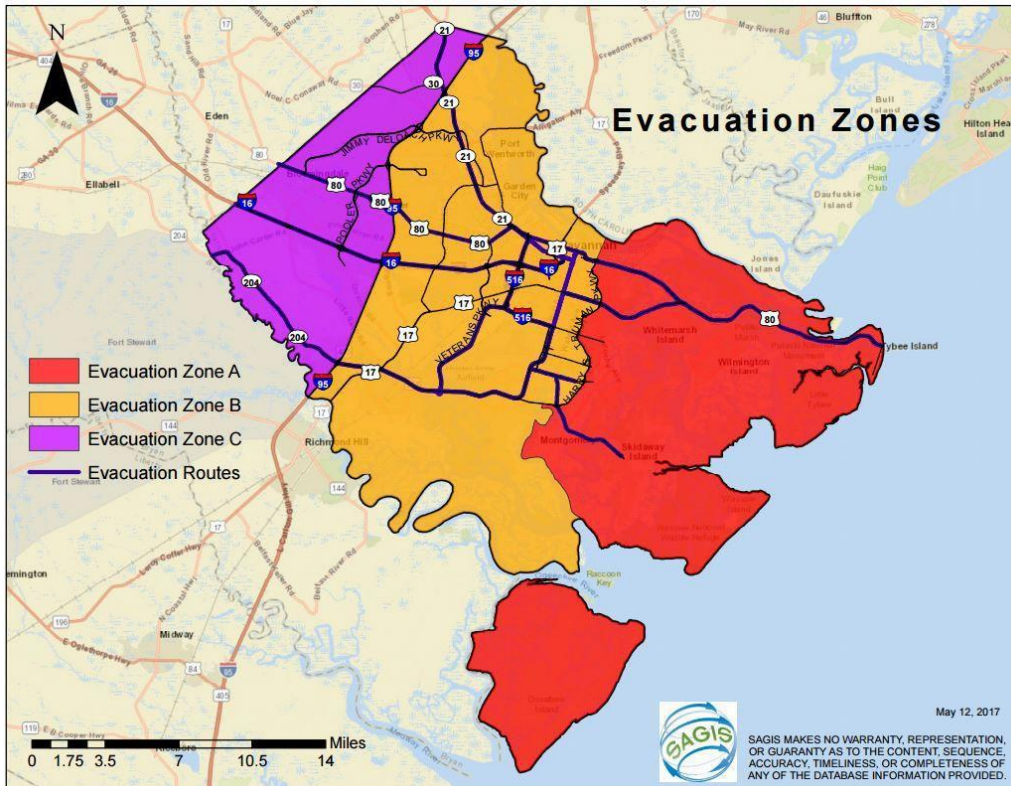

## Hurricane Evacuation Zones



Chatham County utilizes a three-phased zone approach when a Hurricane is threatening our community and evacuation is necessary. The Hurricane Evacuation zones are:

- Zone A – Portions of the county from the Harry Truman Parkway East to the coastline.
- Zone B – Portions of the county from I-95 East to the Harry Truman Parkway.
- Zone C – Portions of the county West of I-95 to the Effingham County and Bryan County line.

## Evacuation Assembly Area (EAA)

The Evacuation Assembly Area serves as a means to coordinate transportation resources for citizens within Chatham County needing public transportation assistance during a **MANDATORY** County evacuation order. The EAA will **NOT** be operational when a general evacuation order has been issued. The activation of the EAA is contingent upon the recommendation of an evacuation from the Director of the Chatham Emergency Management Agency and approval from county leadership.



When a decision to evacuate has been made, the Savannah Civic Center, located at 301 W. Oglethorpe Avenue will serve as the primary EAA location. Citizens requiring transportation support can either walk to the EAA, receive a ride from a friend/family member or be transported via Chatham Area Transit (CAT).

Upon arrival at the EAA there will be two methods of check-in, one for individuals with pets and one with individual without pets. Individuals **without pets** will be directed inside the civic center to the Arena floor. Individuals will be seated by section according to their arrival time in order to be registered. Passengers are then registered and loaded onto buses in accordance with their arrival time. Individuals **with pets** will be directed to a registration area on the porch of the Civic Center. Passenger will first register themselves and then they will complete a pet registration process. There will be trained animal services staff on hand and they can identify if presented animals met the service animal requirements. Service animals will board the bus with their owner while non-service animals will be placed on a pet transport and evacuated separately from their owners.

### **Hurricane Registry**

The Hurricane Registry is a list for those individuals who have Functional, Access or Medical needs. This list is maintained by the Chatham County Health Department and may include individuals who have certain healthcare needs, may need transportation or medical assistance and have no resources such as family members, neighbors or friends who could help them evacuate if a hurricane is threatening the community.

Individuals must apply to be on the Hurricane Registry and that can be done in several different ways. The application for the Hurricane Registry can be downloaded at [gachd.org/registry](http://gachd.org/registry) or individuals may call **1-833-CHD-REGISTER (1-833-243-7344)** and follow the phone prompts. Finally, applications can also be picked up at your local health department.

The time to apply for the registry is **BEFORE** a storm is approaching. Registry applications will **stop being accepted 72 hours prior** to the arrival of tropical storm force winds.

## CEMA Alerts

CEMA encourages everyone who lives, works and visits Savannah and Chatham County to sign up to receive CEMA Alerts through the Community Notification System.


You can receive CEMA Alerts on your cell phone through text messages, through your email and also on your home phone. Those registered will receive alerts for severe weather, missing people, hurricane evacuation notices and other emergency notifications. CEMA Alerts are a free service designed to keep Chatham County residents and visitors informed!

## Operating Conditions (OPCONS)

OPCONS are intended to present a brief summary of the major incident objectives and actions being taken by the County to prepare for and respond to a tropical cyclone threat. The OPCON structure uses timelines referenced to the arrival of tropical storm force winds (39 mph) not the arrival of the Hurricanes center which is referred to as landfall.

The OPCONs progress through hurricane operations from day-to-day monitoring and preparedness efforts (OPCON 5) through direct and / or indirect impacts to Chatham County (OPCON 1) where county-level assistance is required for coordination and support.

### Operating Condition Levels

**OPCON 5 - Preparedness**  
The routine operating level of the CEMA EOC during hurricane season (June 1 - November 30) when there is no direct threat from a tropical cyclone.

**OPCON 4 - Enhanced Monitoring**  
This is an advanced stage of readiness. CEMA moves to this condition when there is the potential for Chatham County to be impacted, directly or indirectly, by a tropical cyclone.

**OPCON 3 - Mobilization**  
This is the operational level where multilateral protective actions are initiated. During this condition, tropical cyclone related hazards are forecast to directly impact Chatham County. The Chatham County Emergency Operation Center is activated during this condition.

**OPCON 2 - Final Preparation**  
During this condition, actions are taken to support both preparedness efforts for direct impact from a tropical cyclone. The Chatham County Emergency Operation Center is activated with necessary staffing during this condition.

**OPCON 1 - Event**  
This is the highest level of operational preparedness. During this condition, protective action is taken in anticipation of the direct impact of a tropical cyclone. The Chatham County Emergency Operation Center is activated with necessary staffing during this condition.
